LAUNCH TEAM FAQ

What does it mean to be on the launch team?

A launch team member is an individual or family that has decided to help us launch Link Church. In essence a launch team member works alongside the lead pastors and lead team of Link Church.

Do I need to have ministry/church experience?

Prior ministry experience is not necessary. We will have several launch team trainings that will prepare you for your specific role prior to the launch.

Do I need to live in Charlotte?

While it is encouraged that you live in the city limits of Charlotte and as close to our launch location as possible, it is not a requirement. As long as you live within driving distance to attend meetings, trainings, events and our gatherings you can live in your location of choice.

What is the time commitment?

This depends upon your specific role and will increase as the launch date approaches. On average we will meet 2 times a month leading up to launch Sunday. You are also asked to be involved in the lives of those around you.
